Let's Get It Started

Have your caterer set up stations to avoid bottlenecks—and create delicious canapés that can be beautifully presented, and served, on platters.

Mixed canapés—white truffle pancake with grilled striploin and tomato fondant, peppered shortbread with beet and chevre, by Culinary Capers. Presented on green resin tray by Martha Sturdy. Fresh flowers from Halfyard Designs.

These canapés pair well with a bubbly like the Sophia Blanc de Blancs from California.

The Main Event

Work with your caterer to devise a menu that reflects the seasonal and geographic offerings from the area where the event is planned.

Roast BC wild salmon topped with a fennel pollen crust alongside summer vegetables from Culinary Capers is served on white marble resin platter from Martha Sturdy. Flowers from Halfyard Designs.

If you prefer white, a crisp, drier chardonnay like Joie Farm Reserve Chardonnay pairs well. As for reds, the full black cherry and spice notes of FoxTrot Pinot Noir are a wonderful complement to roast salmon.
